

**The Terms of Personal Data Management
of the accommodated residents at the Accommodation Facility of the University of
Žilina in Žilina**

1. The resident takes due note that the University of Žilina, Univerzitná Street 8215/1, 010 26 Žilina, Registration number: 00 397 563 (hereinafter referred to as "UNIZA") will process their personal data or personal data of the persons to be accommodated at the extent as stated in the order of accommodation and / or the agreement on accommodation. The purpose of processing of personal data is to provide accommodation and related services. The legal basis for data processing is the accommodation agreement.
2. The data protection officer appointed by the accommodation provider is: Ing. Ľubomíra Sokolová, PhD., e-mail: zodpovedna.osoba@uniza.sk and gdpr@uniza.sk.
3. The provided personal data will be stored for the necessary period required for the purpose of their provision and fulfillment of the obligations of the accommodation provider regarding archiving purposes pursuant to the legislation.
4. The accommodation provider informs the accommodated resident on the following rights arising from the Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council (EU) 2016/679 and The Act No. 18/2018 Coll. on Personal Data Protection (hereinafter "the Regulation" and "the Act"):
 - (a) the right to require from the accommodation provider access to the personal data provided, the right to obtain confirmation on whether his or her personal data are being processed and related information,
 - (b) the right to rectification of personal data in the case of inaccurate or incomplete personal data,
 - (c) the right to erasure of personal data if the legal prerequisites allowing for erasure of personal data ('the right to be forgotten') are met,
 - (d) the right to restriction of processing of personal data if the legal prerequisites permitting the restriction of the processing are met,
 - (e) the right to portability of personal data provided to the accommodation provider, pursuant to the legal preconditions for the data portability met,
 - (f) the right to object and to submit a proposal initiating the proceedings to the Office for Personal Data Protection the purpose of which is to decide whether or not the rights of natural persons have been infringed during the processing of their personal data or whether or not the applicable legislation has been infringed,
5. The accommodation provider confirms that the provided personal data is not being processed via automated individual decision-making, including profiling.
